The objective of the course to prepare for the PhD exam in a foreign language is to improve and further develop the knowledge, skills and abilities of foreign language acquired in the volume of programs at the bachelor's and master's levels, in various types of speech activity.

## 7. Criteria for the final assessment of knowledge

**Reading and translating text with minor semantic grammatical errors in 45 minutes:**

"Satisfactory" - 600 printed signs;

"Good" - 700 printed signs;

"Excellent" - 800 printed signs.

**Written abstracting of the text of 1200 printed characters in 10 minutes:**

"Satisfactory" - 20% of the content;

"Good" - 30% of the content;

"Excellent" - 40% of the content.

**Grammar test with 20 questions:**

"Satisfactory" - 8-13 correct answers;

"Good" - 14-17 correct answers;

"Excellent" - 18-20 correct answers.
